Welcome to my first prison ministry update for 2021. I pray this email finds you and your family safe, well, and hopeful for all that this coming year has to offer. In this newsletter you will see some of our celebrations from 2020, as well as some of our focus points for 2021. There is much to share, so let's get to it!

Ministry Praise Reports

- Kairos Chairman: At the end of 2020 I was voted to become the Chairman of Kairos of San Diego (the local chapter of an international prison ministry organization). This position, and the Kairos ministry in general, has been a major focus of my ministry efforts for the past six months and probably will continue to be so for the entirety of 2021. Time will tell. ⁽³⁾
- Abide Video Series: Last year I worked with a team of men to produce three 30 minute videos for the prison. Since we were unable to go into the prison due to covid, we made these videos as an encouragement. If you have not seen these videos, you can check them out on our YouTube Channel. Through this project, I have been able to develop a relationship with the Community Resource Manager of the CDCR. As of last week, he informed me that our videos have been shown multiple times in 33 of the 35 correctional facilities in Californial MWhat a praise report!
- Christmas & Valentine's Videos: The Christian community came together to make a fun Christmas video, which was received with great joy and appreciation by all the inmates. Due to the Christmas success, we have visions for a Valentine's Day video (with potentially more to follow). Hopefully I'll be able to share some of these videos with you soon. Projects like this draw the child out of us all.
- Newsletters: For several years, it has been on my heart to find ways to keep the volunteer pool of about 400 people engaged and informed with what is going on within the prison and its various programs. Last year I finally established two newsletters; this one, and the Kairos Newsletter. If you would like to receive the Kairos Newsletter, which is sent out on a Monthly basis, please let me know. It is similar, but different. The main difference being, this newsletter contains personal information, while the Kairos newsletter has more of an institutional and program spin.

Ministry Prayer Requests

- Kairos Chairman: That the Lord would give me wisdom and courage in leading this wonderful organization which has such a profound impact on the lives of incarcerated men.
- Abide Video Series: That God would continue to use these videos to bless and change lives, and that we would be given favor to show these videos nationwide. We are currently working with Kalros International to achieve a national distribution.

Personal Update

• Word From God: It has been said, "one word from God can change everything." As 2020 fades in the dawn of 2021, I reflect back on the theme God gave me for 2020. When people were talking about the year of "clear vision" (ironically no one saw COVID comingt), the Lord impressed on my heart the words of Ps 42:1 (As the deer pants for the water, so my soul longs for you). At the time I was uncertain how this word would impact my year, but upon hindsight and reflection, through a tremendous and unprecedented slowing and pruning. He has cultivated within me a renewed fire and passion for my morning devotional routine and time of prayer. Where once I was reading 4 pages of my Bible every morning, now I only read a simple passage, maybe 10 verses, but dive deep and marinate. When it comes to leading the Kairos ministry, He's already given me three goals which I'm excited to accomplish. When it comes to my personal life, I sense He's going to do mighty via my journal

- Personal Change: When I was over at my friend's house the other day, the Holy Spirit ministered to me in a powerful way. While being prayed for, I realized I was mad at God with regard to the situation between me and my dad. My complaint was so, "God, look at how many godly men and women I have praying for him...and we've been praying for years and nothing's changed!" (At least there's been no apparent change from my perspective.) Then the Lord's conviction fell on me like a ton of bricks, "Oh no! If nothing's changed, then I haven't changed." Thus, my prayer life for my father has morphed into the following, "Lord, bring the change within ME that will best foster and usher forth a change in my father's heart. He is such a hateful and angry man and my endurance is beginning to wane. Show me how to minister and tend to his hurts, wounds, and pains, both emotional and spiritual." As of this morning, I came across a timely passage of Scripture which is going to be a great help and a banner for this task (Ps 18:25-32). Please continue to keep him and I in your prayers, for he is by far the most difficult person I've ever been tasked to shepherd.
- Stewardship and Giftedness: On a final note, as I was seeking the Lord's will for my life this year, He reminded me of stewardship and giftedness. As I reflected on my gifts, two rose to the surface: writing & music. Desiring to be a man who uses the gifts God has given me well, this year I plan to write more to my family, friends, and Blog, as well as play more concerts for my neighbors. KAIROS OF SAN DIEGO 2021 PRAYER FOCUS
