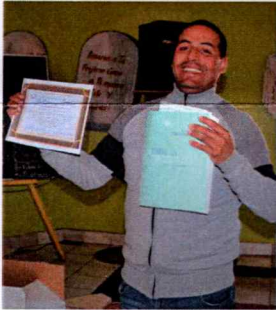
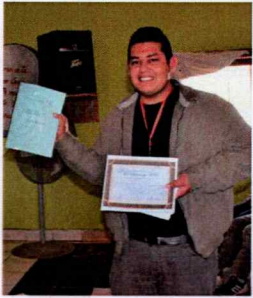
MINISTRY IN CAMALU: I never thought that I was going to be useful in a children's ministry, but for my surprise, I love it and I was able to connect with them with no difficulty during my Wednesday class. Praise God! Many of these children come to my Bible study barefooted, cold and hungry. We cook a light luncheon for them so that they don't go home with an empty stomach. The children are learning the Bible very fast and when I ask them questions they know the answers. Please keep us in prayer. I don't know what God has in mind for me in the future, but **Jeremiah 30:11 says "but I know the thoughts I have about you, thoughts of good and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope."**

RECOVERY HOMES: Presently God has me assigned to bring donations from San Diego. I travel back and forth about four times during the month. One of the most critical challenges at the two centers is the lack of food. The men and women eat morning, lunch and dinner vegetables donated by local markets. Is a feast whenever they can eat chicken or beef. Lately God has been opening doors in San Diego for people who have been donating meat, eggs, milk, oatmeal, cans of food, etc. We thank God for these donations.

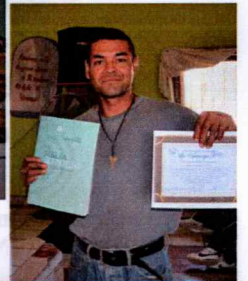
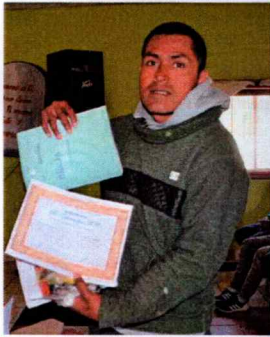
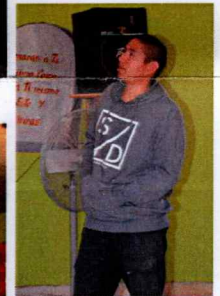

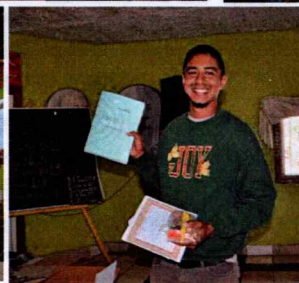
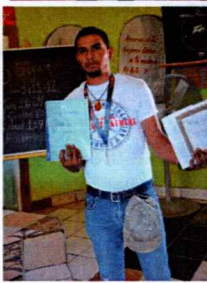
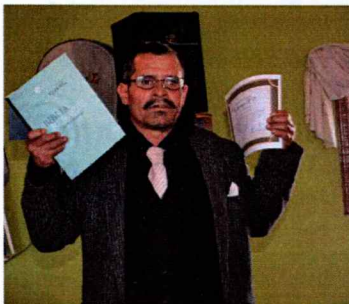
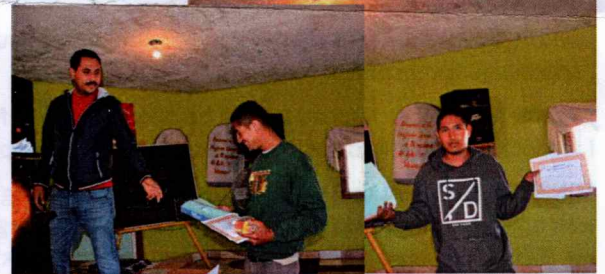
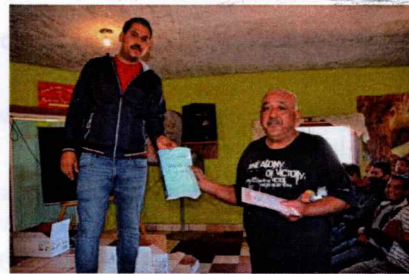
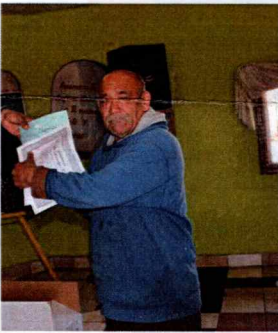
MEN GRADUATED FROM A 3-WEEK INTENSE BIBLE STUDY

One of them is 6-month pregnant and is having a hard time being in confinement since she was heavily addicted to drugs. Another woman is taking psychiatric medication.. Most of the women are peaceful, except the first two weeks when they arrive and are placed in detox. We appreciate the collaboration of local volunteers who help to supervise the women 24/7. CHILDREN'S MINISTRY UPDATE



Currently there are three children's ministry: 1) Jireh Children's ministry in Colonia Vicente Guerrero: A group of about 30 children are fed every Friday from 9:00 a.m.—11:00 a.m. 2) Jireh Children's Ministry in Colonia Tierra Blanca: A group of about 25 to 35 children gather every Saturday morning from 09:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and are fed and have short devotional. 3) Hermana Jovita: A group of about 30 children gather every Saturday to eat from 09:00—11:00 a.m. A new group is going to start feeding children in Colonia Las Aves starting May 1, 2021. 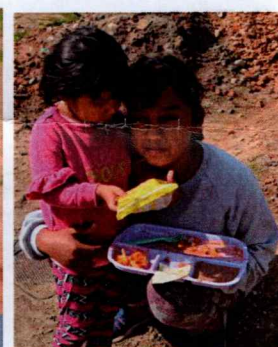
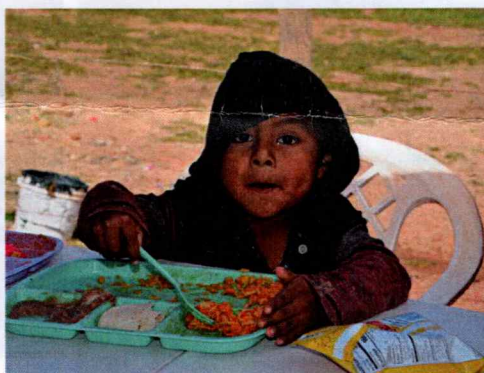
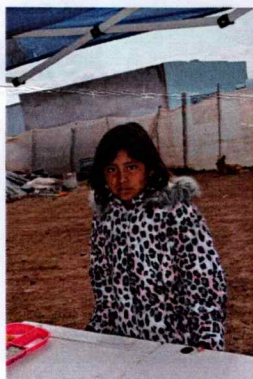
CHILDREN'S MINISTRY: Evaporated milk, Oatmeal, spaghetti and spaghetti sauce, rice, sugar, toilette paper.
